Employment Academy

The Employment Academy is a 5-day workshop that will sharpen your employability skills and prepare you for an effective job search. This comprehensive workshop will also prepare you to attain the Arizona Career Readiness Credential (see below for ACRC description). You will learn the essential elements needed to gain meaningful employment, including evaluating your interests/skills, assessing your work style, locating labor market information, preparing a targeted resume, improving your interview techniques, and much more.

Adult Orientation

The Adult Orientation orients job seekers to the services provided by the ARIZONA@WORK Maricopa County Adult program. Job seekers are offered information and resources that will enable them to take advantage of job search and career planning services. In addition, they will understand their next steps in their path to employment.

Resumes and More

This course will enable participants to create/improve their resume to meet the needs of hiring companies. **Resume/LinkedIn Lab:** following the workshop, a designated computer lab is staffed with a trainer to help you in creating a great resume or improving your LinkedIn profile. **For resume lab assistance, attend the resume workshop first. Bring a flash drive to save your work. For LinkedIn assistance, workshop attendance is not required.**

Igniting Your Interview

Topics include: the framework of an interview, proper attire, how to answer the most common questions, and post-interview strategies. To practice for your next interview, a **mock interview** may be scheduled. Talk to one of our trainers for more details.

LinkedIn Basics

In this presentation, participants will learn the basics of setting up a LinkedIn profile. The **Resume/LinkedIn Lab** is available for those who desire help with improving or creating a LinkedIn profile. **For LinkedIn assistance, attending this LinkedIn presentation is not required.**

Arizona Career Readiness Credential (ACRC)
