Arizona Job Connection is Arizona's online job listing, case management and reporting system. Registered job seekers are able to use <u>Arizona Job Connection</u> to explore jobs, create résumés and find education and training programs.

Our Career Planners use the system to match, refer and recommend qualified job seekers to current job opportunities that are listed in the system.

Employers are able to post their job openings and search for qualified candidates for employment opportunities.
