- 63 employers are attending job fair at Cochise College on March 23.
- 60 employers are attending job fair at Downtown Center on March 24.
- Career fair at Benson High School on April 6. Students will get experience with applications and resumes. There will be simulated interviews.
- Job fair at Cochise College Douglas Campus on April 13.
- Vickie Simmons highlighted the Success Stories in the packet.
- Vada Phelps noted a newspaper article about recent Dispatcher graduates. AZ@Work funded the tuition of all of the graduates.

Rehabilitation Services report was presented by Elizabeth Kinder.
