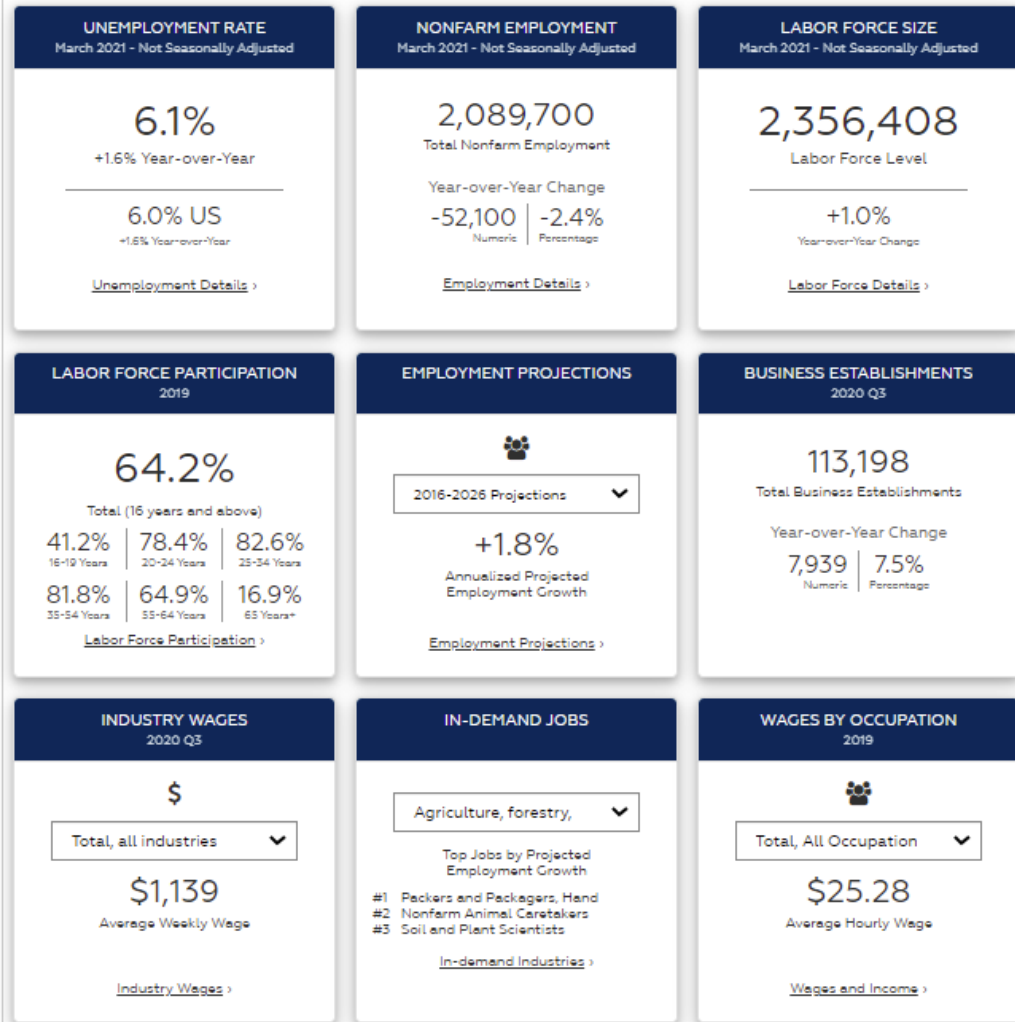

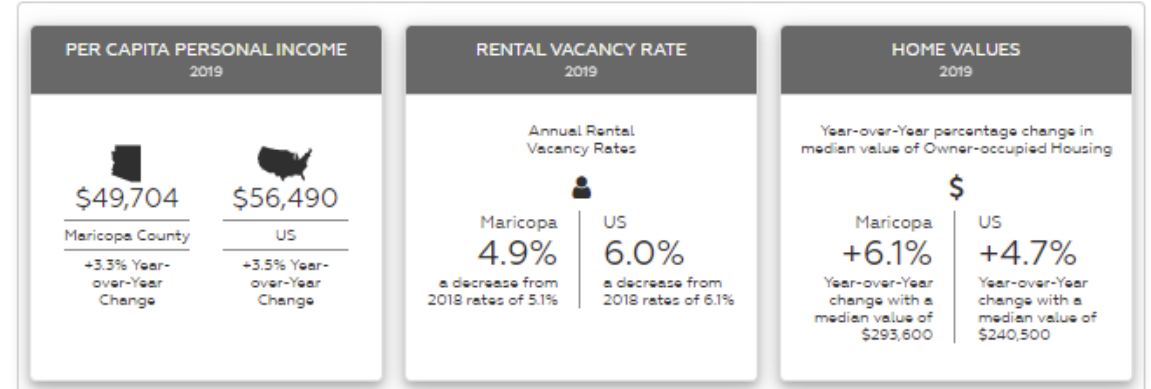
LABOR: MARICOPA COUNTY
