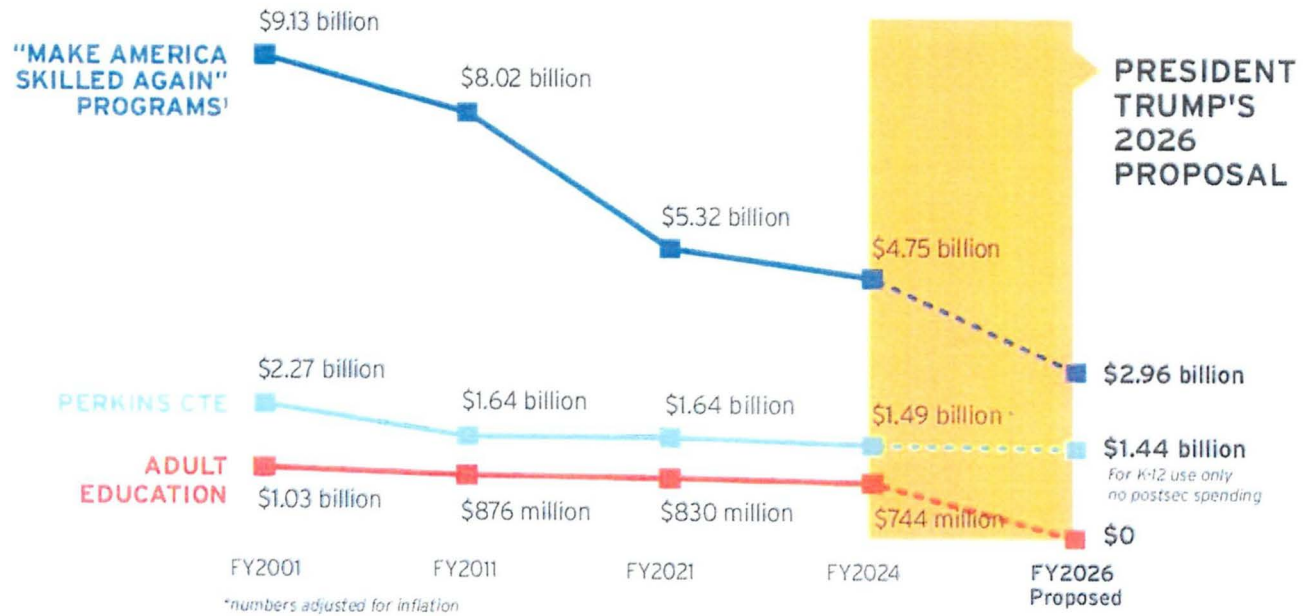




# THE PRESIDENT'S PROPOSED BUDGET INCLUDES DEEP CUTS TO WORKFORCE

# Make America Skilled Again (MASA) Program-Proposed FY26 Budget

- **Replaces 11 federal workforce programs**, including WIOA Adult, Youth, DWG, Apprenticeship, and Workforce Data Quality Initiative.
- Funded at **\$2.96 billion**, down from \$4.0B in prior year's allocations
- States gain **broad flexibility** to design programs tailored to local economies
- Must spend **at least 10% on Registered Apprenticeships**
- Eliminated Federal funding for **Job Corps, REO, YouthBuild, and DEI-focused nonprofits**
- **Outcome-based accountability** replaces current federal reporting guidelines
  - Focus on **employment results**, divests from compliance bureaucracy
- **Unknown today** - FY 2026 starts Oct 1, 2025 - possible implementation n
