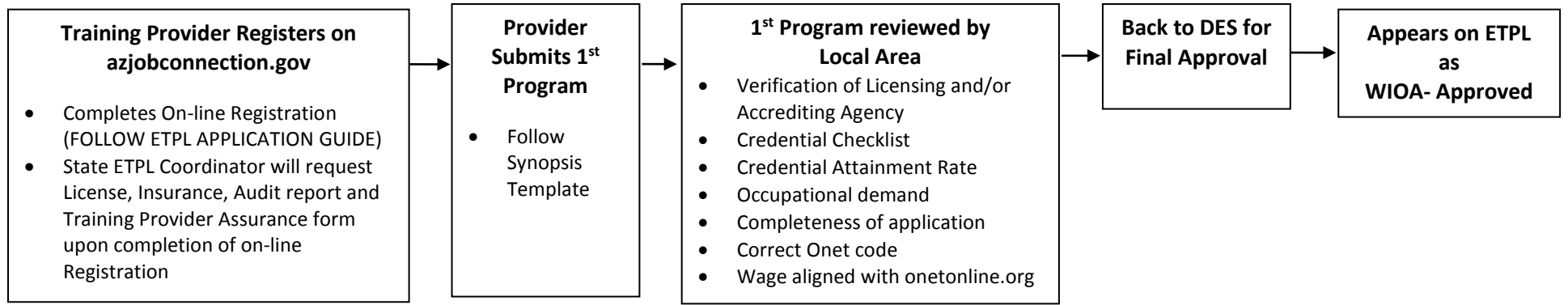

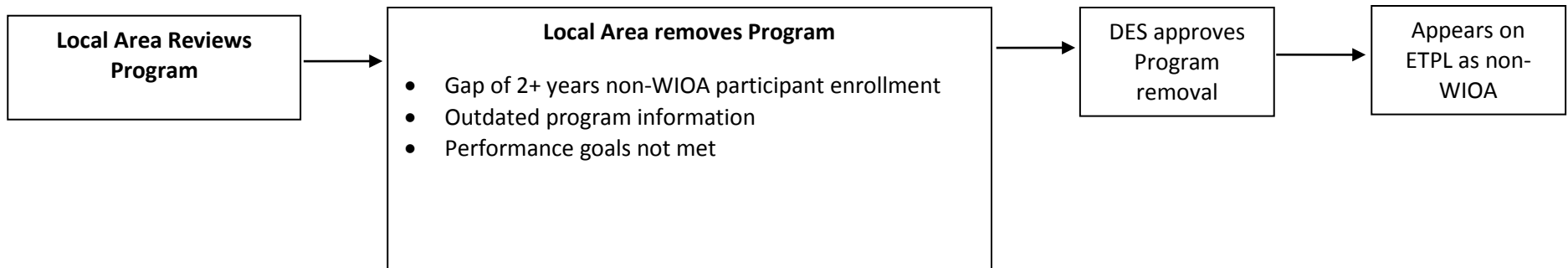
Provider Registration and Initial Program Approval

Training Provider Qualifications

<p>Types of Training Providers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Institution of higher learning that provides a program leading to a post-secondary credential • Registered Apprenticeship programs (federal or state-approved) • Other public or private providers of training including joint labor-management agencies and providers of adult education and literacy activities when combined with occupational skills training • Training program must be occupational 	<p>Licensing</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Licensed by appropriate state or federal licensing authority; i.e. Arizona Private Post-secondary Education, Arizona Board of Nursing, Department of Transportation, Arizona Board of Cosmetology • Providers of adult education and literacy must be listed on the Arizona Department of Education list of ABE providers 	<p>Business Requirements</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must have physical presence in Arizona and permanent mailing address (PO Box is not acceptable) • Must be registered to do business in AZ • Must have provided licensed training for twelve consecutive months prior to ETPL application • Certificate of Liability Insurance • Grievance procedure • Refund policy
<p>Federally-recognized Credentials</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High School Diploma, GED or HSE • Educational certificates based on credit hours for a program of study (not a single class) • Associate’s Degree • Bachelor’s Degree • Postgraduate Degrees 	<p>Industry-recognized Credentials</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Registered Apprenticeship Certificates • Occupational Licenses granted by federal, state or regulatory bodies; i.e. barber license, CDL, nursing license 	<p>Personnel Certification</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be industry-recognized or result in professional association certification • Granted by 3rd party non-gov’t agency • Requires successful completion of exam; i.e. CompTIA, Medical Assistant
<p>Training Program Requirements</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Train for occupations in demand locally • Align with industry sector strategies and career pathways • Job-driven (meet local employer needs) • Serve individuals with barriers • Serve individuals who are employed 	<p>Technology-Based Learning</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must meet Arizona licensing requirements • Have a mechanism for student interaction • Have a mechanism for tracking participation • Provide periodic assessment of students 	<p>Third Party Training Providers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Disclosure in ETPL program synopsis • Licensed for post-secondary training • If out-of-state be on that state’s ETPL • Comply with WIOA and ETPL requirements • Must provide outcome data • Certificate issued by ETPL provider
