Virtual Adult Orientation

The Virtual Adult Orientation is an introduction to the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA). You will learn about the services and resources available to Job Seekers through ARIZONA@WORK Maricopa County along with the Occupational Skills Training Grant, the high demand industry areas, and the steps needed to apply for Career Planning Services.

Arizona Career Readiness Credential (ACRC)

Demonstrate to employers that you have mastered the skills that are most important to success! The credential process involves an initial skills assessment, instructional courseware, and successful completion of a battery of assessments in critical skill areas. Office Proficiency Assessment and Certification (OPAC)
